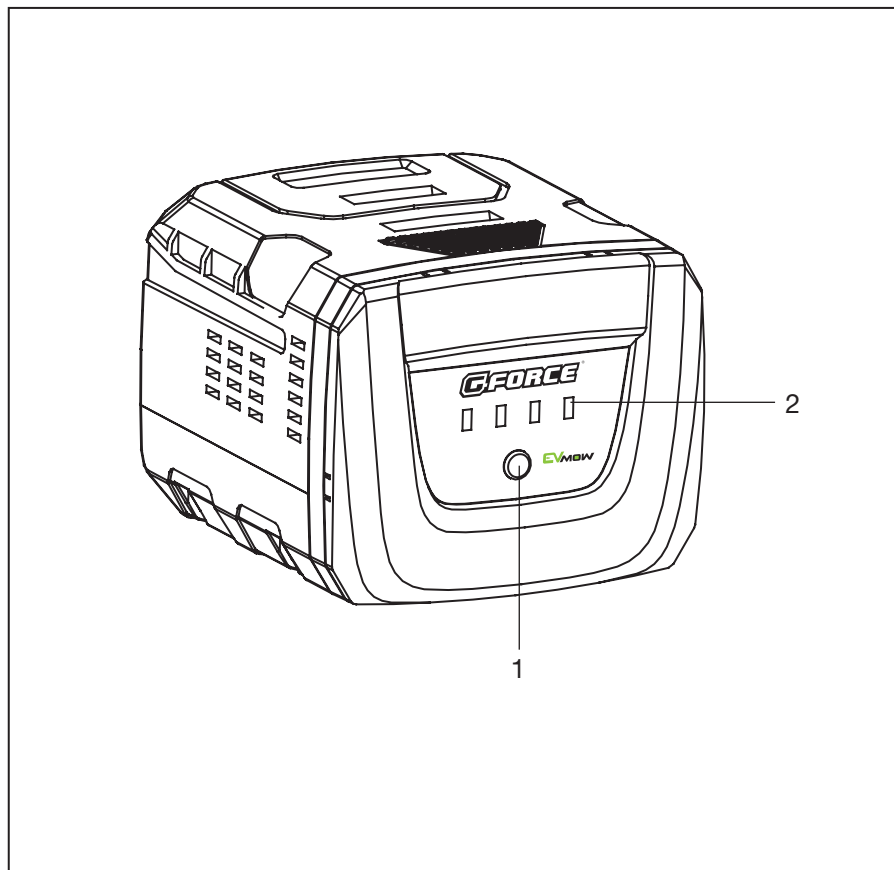

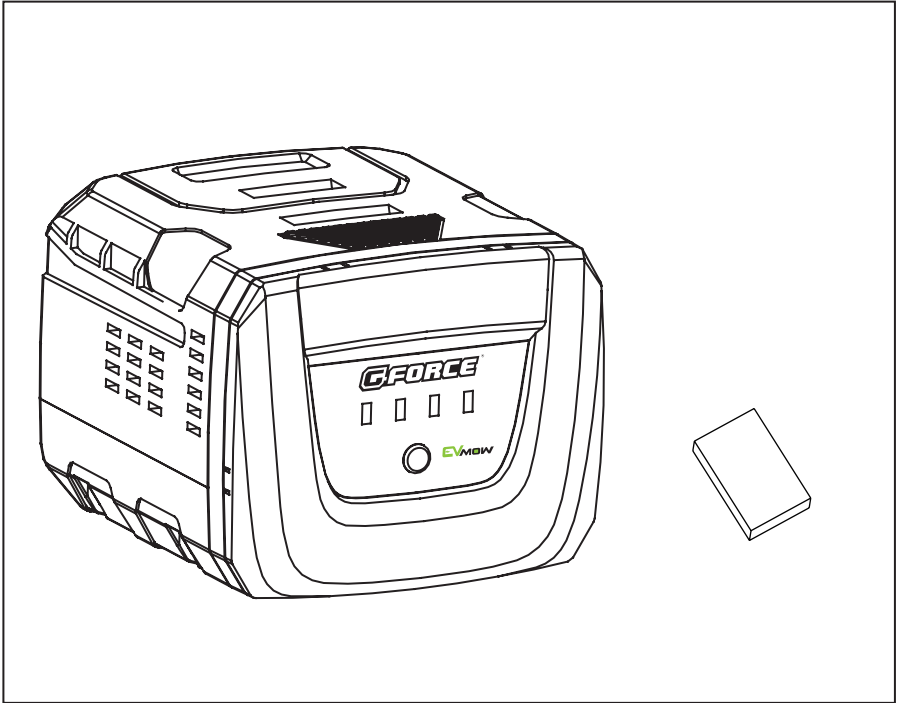
## DESCRIPTION OF PRODUCT PARTS

This **G-FORCE** 60V lithium-ion battery pack is intended for use with **G-FORCE** cordless tools. This battery pack should only be charged by a **G-FORCE** 60V battery charger. This battery pack is designed for domestic use only, it is not designed for commercial, trade or industrial use.

## **GENERAL SAFETY WARNINGS**

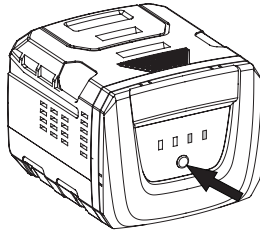
- a) Do not dismantle, open or shred secondary cells or batteries.
- b) Do not expose cells or batteries to heat or fire. Avoid storage in direct sunlight.
- c) Do not short-circuit a cell or a battery. Do not store cells or batteries haphazardly in a box or drawer where they may short-circuit each other or be short-circuited by other metal objects.
- d) Do not remove a cell or battery from its original packaging until required for use.
- e) Do not subject cells or batteries to mechanical shock.
- f) In the event of a cell leaking, do not allow the liquid to come in contact with the skin or eyes. If contact has been made, wash the affected area with copious amounts of water and seek medical advice.
- g) Do not use any charger other than that specifically provided for use with the equipment.
- h) Observe the plus (+) and minus (-) marks on the cell, battery and equipment and ensure correct use.

## OPERATION

### Power indicators

This Li-Ion battery pack is equipped with four power indicators that are used to show the battery pack's remaining charge. Press the power indicator button to check the battery charge. The LEDs will stay lit for approximately 4 seconds.



### To obtain the best life from the battery pack

1. Never allow the battery pack to be completely discharged before recharging. The battery pack should be charged whenever the battery pack is noticeably running down.
2. Avoid conducting short charges. Make sure that the battery pack is fully charged each time by allowing the charger to complete its full charging cycle.
3. Always unplug the charger when not in use and store it in a dry and secure place.
4. Avoid charging or storing your battery pack in temperatures below 5°C and above 45°C.
5. After use, allow the battery pack to cool down for approximately 30 minutes before attempting to recharge it.

## MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

### Cleaning

Clean the battery pack with a soft, clean and dry brush.

### Transport

This lithium-ion battery pack is subject to the Dangerous Goods Legislation requirements and is suitable for ground transportation by the user without further conditions.

When being transported by third parties (e.g.: air transport or forwarding agency), special requirements on packaging and labelling must be observed. For preparation of the item being shipped, consulting an expert for hazardous material is absolutely required. Dispatch the batteries only

when the housing is undamaged. Tape or mask off open contacts and pack up the battery pack in such a manner that it cannot move around in the packaging. Please also observe possible additional national regulations.

## **DISPOSAL**



Dispose of the battery pack according to the regulations and requirements of your local council.



## **WARRANTY**

This product is covered by a 1 year parts and labour warranty against manufacturing defects.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law.

You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

This warranty will not apply:

- (i) where this product has been subjected to misuse, abuse, accident or want of care;
- (ii) where this product has been used for a purpose for which it was not designed or is not suited;
- (iii) where the service of this product has been undertaken by a non-authorized person or company or if non-approved parts have been used;
- (iv) where this product has been used for trade, industrial or commercial purposes.

In order to obtain warranty service, the purchaser must present the store receipt showing the name of the retailer and the date of purchase.

The period of the warranty begins from the original date of purchase, notwithstanding any subsequent repair or parts replacement.

Purchaser shall be responsible for all transport charges to and from the Authorised Service Centre.

Damage in transit is not covered by this warranty. The purchaser should remove from the product any liquids (if applicable) before sending the product for service or repair.

The product should be packed securely to prevent damage.

Wear parts or service related parts required when performing normal and regular maintenance of this product are not covered by warranty unless it is found to be defective by an Authorised Service Centre.
